Notice of Upcoming Elections Sunday, May 19, 2024 Voting 9 AM to 1 PM

The Italia America Bocce Club will hold its annual election on Sunday, May 19, 2024, at the club facility, 2210 Marconi, St. Louis, MO 63110. Voting will begin at 9 AM and end promptly at 1 PM. Those members in good standing, with either a membership card or photo identification, may vote one ballot. The member must be present to vote. Absentee and proxy ballots are not permitted.

This election will be held to replace three (3) Director positions on the Board of Directors. The three (3) Director positions are each a three-year term. The election committee has reviewed and approved the below listed members seeking to fill the vacant positions.

The committee has made no recommendation of any member over another. Candidates will be listed on the ballot in order of submission to the election committee.

- You must first go to the website STLBocce.Com to see if your date is available. If date is available, print, complete and submit the contract along with the rental fee in person to Director, Sally Drago. Sally and the member will review the contract together. Once everything is agreed upon, she will present it to the board at the next board meeting.
- 2. Members are required to have 6 months of active, continuous membership to qualify for a rental.
- 3. All events require approval from the Board of Directors of the IABC. These meetings are usually held the 2nd Monday of each month.
- 4. Sally will contact the member to indicate whether the rental request was approved, denied, or requires further information from the IABC Board.
- 5. If the event was approved, Sally will meet in person or discuss via phone call the details of the contract which you need to have already thoroughly read.

Men's Early Monday Summer 2024 Bocce League

- There will be a Captains Meeting at 6:00 pm on Monday, May 20th at the club. At this meeting, we can discuss any changes to the regulations of this league. Captains can pre-register their teams by sending the name of their team and the members of the team to Angelo Sita.
- On June 10th, the Bocce Club will be starting the Early Summer League.
- The league will begin play at 5:00 pm on Monday, June 10th.
- The league will run for 8 or 10 weeks and ends on either Monday, July 29th or Monday, August 12th. (no bocce June 24th due to USBF Nationals)
- This Summer league will begin play at 5:00 pm. The cost to play in this league will be \$15.00 per person.
- Each team can have up to 8 members on a team, and since it is a summer league a team can play a game with only 2 team members. Teenage boys, 16 years old and older, could play on a team with a father, grandfather, or uncle.
- The first team to get 12 points wins. Frames will not be used.
- To make the league more competitive for new members, each team can throw no more than 3 "Hit Shots or Volo Shots" per game. The captain of the opposing team is responsible for keeping track of how many times his opponents throw a hit shot.
- All members of a team cannot have a meeting to discuss how a particular ball should be played. A player can only consult with his teammate at his end of the court. This rule does not apply to boys who are new to the game or men who have never been on a team before.
- All players must stay behind the first white line on the courts during play, but they can cross the line to determine which ball is closest to the pallino.
- The team with the winning record will be the league champion. In case two teams have the same winning record, there will be a one game playoff to determine the winner.

At the conclusion of the season, there will be a cash prize of \$20.00 to each member of the winning team. There will be no prizes for second and third place teams.

Monday Night Mixed League: Mixed League. Open play with no hitting limitations. Form your team with any combination of men and women or all men, all women. If more than 10 teams register, the game times will rotate between 7pm and 8:30pm.

Tuesday Pick-up: Robert Della Croce will do a blind draw of cards for teams. Start time is 7:00 pm sharp! You need to be at the club no later than 6:30 to play as the number of teams allowed is limited on this night. Cost is \$ 5.00 per person for this game each Tuesday. Start date is Tuesday, May 7, 2024.

Wednesday COED League: You must have two (2) men and two (2) women for your team. - start time to be determined by number of teams. The contact for that league is Dan Drago.

Thursday Night League: Men's league. Thursday game times will be at 6:45pm. If more than ten teams register, the game times will rotate between 6:45pm and 8:30pm. If more than ten teams register, the game times will rotate between 7pm and 8:30pm.

Bocce with the Best! The Italia America Bocce Club in St. Louis is proud to be hosting the 2024 United States Bocce Federation National Championship June 23 - 29, 2024. This is our ninth time hosting the USBF National Championship and our club welcomes those who have been here before and those who have not yet participated or attended this great event. We hope you enjoy the club, our city, the competition, the camaraderie, and the sportsmanship of your fellow bocce players from across the United States. All players must be a USBF card holder. These may be purchased from Robert Della Croce at the IABC.

- The USBF Championship has two (2) different components, Open Bocce and Punto Raffa Volo (PRV).
- This year's PRV events of Men's Doubles and Women's Doubles are non-qualifiers and will be played to 12 points or 55 minutes. The qualifying events to represent the USA in the World Championship in Turkey are Mixed Doubles, Men's PRV Singles, and Women's PRV Singles and they will be played to 12 points or 8 frames. The PRV Mixed Doubles team members do not have to belong to the same club. The PRV matches will be staggered, to allow for play in multiple PRV events. There will also be a Men's and Women's Precision Shooting Contest.
- The Open Tournament is for medals and money and must consist of four (4) players (men, women, or mixed), and these games will be played to 12 points or 55 minutes. The Open team members do not have to belong to the same club. USBF Open rules will apply.
- Registration deadline for all events is Wednesday, May 15, 2024.
- Several PRV events and the Open Tournament will be broadcast throughout the week on the Bocce Broadcast Network.

The Awards Banquet will be Saturday, June 29, 2024 - 7:00 PM. Cost is \$ 50.00 per person and guests are welcome to purchase tickets. Tickets must be purchased at the time of your registration for you and your guests.
